

## Prostate-specific antigen is a "chymotrypsin-like" serine protease:

- It belongs to the human kallikrein family of proteases and possesses a substrate specificity similar to that of chymotrypsin.
- PSA inhibitors represent a promising class of research compounds.
  - Measure the inhibition of PSA's proteolytic activity with a chromogenic substrate, such as the Diapharama CS PSA (KLK3)

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
